


Month-wise break up of RSS in II Quarter (Oct-Dec)








Month-wise break up of Mega Events in II Quarter (Oct-Dec)

There was extremely healthy debate and interaction on these subjects, which was appreciated both by participants and faculty members.






REASERCH AND ETHICS PROGRAM

The road map of this project was based on five training sessions on Medical First Responder (MFR). Self-Employment of Women in Private Health Sector - Training of DoHs Staff Trainers- 06 Month Project


The Shifa List Program has achieved accreditation of two years and became the 9th BLS Provider and 6th ACLS Provider in the country.








Overview of Courses Conducted




BLS Result Summary (Oct-Dec)






