Mission of this workshop was to differentiate mobilization from manipulation and to discuss major school of thoughts in manipulation and to perform lumbar spine manipulation.




Details of BLS courses conducted from July – December 2021 were 30.

As per requirement of AHA, LiST has conducted the quality assurance audit of the BLS course.





Mission of this activity was to understand the HEC Journal recognition system.


PG-Core Competency Course: Mission of this course was to enhance the core competency of Post Graduates of SIH with the research applications.
